

One Care enrollment application

You can get One Care if:

- you are between the ages of 21 and 64, have a disability
- you have Medicare Parts A and B*
- you qualify for Medicare Part D (drug coverage)**
- you have MassHealth Standard or MassHealth CommonHealth***
- you do not have private health insurance (like health insurance from your job)
- you do not take part in a Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) waiver
- you live in an area covered by a One Care plan

When do I use this form?

You can join a plan:

- Between October 15–December 7 each year (for coverage starting January 1)
- Within three months of first getting Medicare
- In certain situations where you're allowed to join or switch plans

What do I need to complete this form?

- Your Medicare Number (the number on your red, white, and blue Medicare card)
- Your permanent address and phone number

Note: You must complete all items in Section 1. The items in Section 2 are optional — you can't be denied coverage because you don't fill them out.

Reminders:

- If you want to join a plan during fall open enrollment (October 15–December 7), the plan must get your completed form by December 7.

Mass General Brigham One Care is a health plan that contracts with both Medicare and MassHealth (Medicaid) to provide benefits of both programs to enrollees. Enrollment in the plan depends on the plan's contract renewal with Medicare. This plan is a voluntary program that is available to anyone age 21-64 who qualifies for MassHealth Standard or CommonHealth and Original Medicare and does not have any other comprehensive health insurance, except Medicare.

PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) collects information from Medicare plans to track beneficiary enrollment in Medicare Advantage (MA) Plans, improve care, and for the payment of Medicare benefits.
