DATE OF RECALL: March 14, 2025

DRUG NAME: Sodium Bicarb Injection

RECALLING FIRM: Exela

REASON FOR RECALL: Exela announced a voluntary recall of two lots of 8.4% sodium bicarbonate injection because a defective crimp in the vial may cause the stopper to dislodge from the vial when the fliptop is being removed. The defective crimp on the vial may expose the drug product to the environment and could potentially impact the sterility and purity of the product.
