Overview

Corifact is indicated in adult and pediatric patients with congenital Factor XIII deficiency for routine prophylactic treatment and peri-operative management of surgical bleeding.

All other indications are considered experimental/investigational and not medically necessary.

Coverage Guidelines

Authorization may be granted for members new to the plan who are currently receiving treatment with the requested medication, excluding when the product is obtained as samples or via manufacturer's patient assistance programs.

OR

Authorization may be granted when the following criteria is met:

1. Member has a diagnosis of Factor XIII deficiency.

Continuation of Therapy

Reauthorization may be granted for continued treatment when the member is experiencing benefit from therapy (e.g., reduced frequency or severity of bleeds).

Limitations

1. Initial approvals and reauthorizations will be granted for 12 months.
