### Overview

Miebo (perfluorohexyloctane ophthalmic solution) is indicated for the treatment of the signs and symptoms of dry eye disease (DED).

## **Coverage Guidelines**

Authorization may be granted for members new to Mass General Brigham Health Plan who are currently receiving treatment with the requested medication excluding when the product is obtained as samples or via manufacturer's patient assistance programs.

#### OR

Authorization may be granted for members meeting ALL the following criteria:

- 1. Member has a diagnosis of dry eye disease
- 2. The member has inadequate response, intolerance, or contraindication to artificial tears product
- 3. The member has inadequate response, intolerance, or contraindication to Restasis (brand)

#### **Continuation of Therapy**

Authorization may be granted for members for continued treatment when provider attests to improvement in signs and symptoms of dry eye disease from baseline (e.g., ocular irritation, redness, mucous discharge, reduced visual function, ocular surface damage, reduced tear production).

### Limitations

1. Initial approvals and reauthorizations will be granted for 12 months
