Overview

Accrufer is indicated for the treatment of iron deficiency or iron deficiency anemia in adults.

Coverage Guidelines

Authorization may be reviewed for members new to AllWays Health Partners who are currently receiving treatment with Acrrufer excluding when the product is obtained as samples or via manufacturer's patient assistance programs.

OR

Authorization may be granted for members when ALL the following criteria are met, and documentation is provided:

- 1. The member has a diagnosis of iron deficiency
- The member has paid claims or physician documented inadequate response or adverse reaction to THREE of the four oral iron products: ferrous fumarate, ferrous gluconate, ferrous sulfate or polysaccharide iron complex
- 3. The member has attempted strategies to improve tolerability of other iron products if gastrointestinal adverse events occurred has been attempted

Continuation of Therapy

Reauthorization will be granted when provider documents continuation of therapy and positive response to therapy.

Limitations

1. Initial approvals and reauthorizations will be granted for 24 months
