

Off Label Medical Specialty Medication Authorization Process

- 1. Requests for Medical Specialty Meds (<u>under medical benefit on or off label</u>) on Prior Authorization (PA):
 - These requests must be submitted by the provider to Specialty Fusion, who will then review. If denied, an appeal can be submitted to Mass General Brigham Health Plan.
 - If auth request is submitted to Mass General Brigham Health Plan, the auth will be closed and the provider will be notified to redirect to Specialty Fusion.
- 2. Requests for Medical Specialty Meds (<u>under medical benefit on or off label</u>) not on PA:
 - Requests submitted by provider for off label use of medication not on PA, will be <u>CLOSED</u> with attribute "No PA required".
- 3. Requests for combination* Therapy Medical Specialty Meds (<u>under medical benefit on or off</u> label): ex.: one medication is on PA with Specialty Fusion and another is not:
 - The medication(s) on PA with Specialty Fusion must be submitted by the provider to Specialty Fusion, who will then review.
 - If auth request (for specialty med. reviewed by Specialty Fusion) is submitted to Mass General Brigham Health Plan, the auth will be **closed** and provider notified to redirect to Specialty Fusion.
 - The medication(s) <u>not on PA</u>, submitted by the provider to Mass General Brigham Health Plan for review will be <u>CLOSED</u> with attribute "no PA required".
 - The medication(s) on PA with Mass General Brigham Health Plan will be reviewed.

*Requests for medical specialty drugs are not reviewed as combination therapies/treatment, they are reviewed as individual products.

Auth Closure Attributes:

- AC No Prior Authorization Required
- AC PA for Drug Required by Specialty Fusion

***<u>Please note, this does not include the Rx benefit auth process via (retail pharmacy)</u> – provider should follow business as usual process for Rx.
