About the Value HMO

What are the advantages of the Value HMO?

Your Value HMO plan keeps your cost sharing simple with no deductibles and straightforward copays. You'll get access to our strong network that includes world-class hospitals like Massachusetts General Hospital and Brigham and Women's, as well as many local doctors you already see. If you ever have questions about your plan, you can reach out to the friendly and knowledgeable members of our customer service team by phone, email, or live chat. They'll also work with you to make transitioning your care to Mass General Brigham Health Plan as smooth and stress-free as possible.

How does an HMO work?

In an HMO you have a Primary Care Provider (PCP) who is your health advocate and coach, providing care when you are sick and preventive care to keep you as healthy as you can be. When you need specialty care, your PCP will provide a referral. Referrals are not required to visit a gynecologist or obstetrician for routine, preventive, or urgent care; family planning services; outpatient and diversionary behavioral health services; physical therapy; occupational therapy; speech therapy; routine eye exam; and emergency services. Through your Value HMO coverage, you're always covered for urgent and emergency care no matter where you travel.

Which providers are in the Value HMO network?

The Value HMO network is designed to help ensure access to the highest quality care with the greatest value for City of Boston employees and retirees. Many of the region's most respected institutions are part of our network – Massachusetts General Hospital, Brigham and Women's Hospital, Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center, Lahey Clinic, Mass Eye and Ear, Boston Medical Center, New England Baptist Hospital, Newton-Wellesley Hospital, Salem Hospital, South Shore Hospital, and many more. We also work with many of the leading provider organizations like Atrius Health, including Harvard Vanguard. Which providers do not participate in the Value HMO network?

How much does your plan cost?

No. Just straightforward copayments for medical and behavioral care, as well as prescription drug coverage.

You pay nothing, or a lower cost, for many OTC drugs with a prescription.
