You decide where to receive care, so you have more control over your own out-of-pocket costs.

How does it work?

When you get care in a hospital or affiliated facility, your cost sharing depends on whether you go to a Tier 1 (lowest cost), Tier 2 (middle cost), or Tier 3 (highest cost) location. You pay less when you get certain services at a lower-tier hospital.

How are hospitals tiered?

Hospitals must meet the standards for quality and cost based on our benchmark. Participating hospitals are classified into three tiers as described below:

Tier 1, lowest cost

These hospitals, community health centers, and free-standing facilities offer the most value relative to cost-efficiency and have the lowest member cost-sharing for certain covered services.

Tier 2, middle cost

These hospitals and affiliated facilities still have moderate cost relative to our benchmark and have moderate member cost-sharing for certain covered services.

Tier 3, highest cost

Hospitals and affiliated facilities assigned to this tier have the highest cost relative to our benchmark and have the highest member cost-sharing for certain covered services.

Why Choice Easy Tier?

- Full access to our broad hospital network
- No tiering for primary care providers or specialist office visits
- Labs are not tiered
- Pay less in copayments, coinsurance, and deductibles when you get certain services at a lower-tier hospital, including:
 - Inpatient acute medical services
 - Outpatient diagnostic imaging and X-ray, including ultrasound
 - Outpatient high-tech radiology (CT scans, MRIs, etc.)
 - Outpatient surgery
 - Outpatient short-term rehabilitation (cardiac, physical, occupational, and speech therapy)
- Many hospitals and affiliated facilities are in the lowest-cost tier, including popular local hospitals like Newton-Wellesley Hospital, Salem Hospital, and South Shore Hospital
